Becoming a Doctor of Pharmacy The Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree program requires at least two years of undergraduate study and four academic years of graduate study. Generally speaking, non-U.S. pharmacy students must meet the same admission requirements as U.S. students, including prerequisites and standardized tests.

You'll also be required to meet mandatory health and legal checks before undertaking a clinical placement. Apply for 'provisional' registration.
