The long-eared owl (*Asio otus*), also known as the northern long-eared owl or, more informally, as the lesser horned owl or cat owl, is a medium-sized species of owl with an extensive breeding range. The scientific name is from Latin. The genus name *Asio* is a type of eared owl, and *otus* also refers to a small, eared owl.

Long-eared Owls are buoyant fliers, appearing to glide noiselessly even when their wings are flapping. They are very manoeuvrable and can fly through fairly dense brush. They fly moth-like, often hovering and fluttering while looking for prey. When roosting, a Long-eared Owl will stretch its body to make itself appear like a tree branch.

Population Trend: The long-eared owl (*Asio otis*) often is considered an enigma by birders and ornithologists. It is shy, quiet, and secretive. This makes its population trends difficult to understand, but the species appears to be declining and is listed as endangered, threatened or of special concern in other states.

Long-Eared Owl

Long-eared owl could be confused with the congeneric short-eared owl (*Asio flammeus*) when flying, as both owls have long wings with low wing-loading and buffy patches near the ends of the upper wings. Both species are also aerial hunters known to use similar open habitats for foraging.

Long-eared owl (Asio otus)

Generally rare and seldom-seen, but can gather in communal winter roosts with dozens of individuals (if you're lucky enough to find a roost, do not disturb the birds). Size and shape similar to Short-eared Owl; but Long-eared is darker and more coarsely marked below with orange patch near the wingtips.

The long-eared owl is a slender, crow-sized owl with long "ear" tufts atop the head that are often visible when the owl perches. The ear tufts are not actual ears, but rather clusters of feathers that aid in camouflaging the bird. The true ears are located on either side of the head next to the round rusty-orange facial disk.

and Fitton (1998) described the Long-eared Owl as a "widespread breeder" recorded in 33 (45%) of 74 atlas blocks in the Glass Mountain area of Mono County. To the east and south, the species is an "uncommon" resident in the White-Inyo Range; nesting has been documented in the White Mountains as high at 9500 ft (2896 m)

Long-eared owl (Asio otus) - California

Long-eared owls are strictly nocturnal. They live in pairs during the breeding season, but are tolerant of other long-eared owls, and often roost in groups of 2 to 20 during the non-breeding season. During the breeding season, long-eared owls defend only the area immediately surrounding the nest.

Long-eared owls are medium-sized owls. They have long, rounded wings and a long tail. The wings are so long that they cross each other in the back when the bird is perched. The wingspan of adults ranges from 90 to 100 cm. Long-eared owls are brownish gray, with vertical streaks.
